

Bedhampton Gyrotory Improvement Works Notice to Businesses / Residents

22/08/11

This notice is intended to provide further information to the businesses and residents located nearby the Bedhampton Gyrotory in Havant.

Dear Resident / Business,

I am writing to update you on the junction improvement works at the Bedhampton Gyrotory, also known as the Rusty Cutter Roundabout.

The works are being undertaken to enable the development of the nearby Harts Farm Way site, which is expected to create up to 800 new jobs in the area, to proceed. They will also improve peak traffic flows across the roundabout.

The project has suffered delays due to unforeseen circumstances resulting in redesign of some sections. The current anticipated completion date is 21st October 2011.

We will be continuing to undertake surfacing, white lining and applying surface treatments to the gyrotory, spurs and slip roads throughout the rest of August. These works will require road and lane closures at night .

In addition to this, we will be undertaking the same surfacing activities plus bridge deck waterproofing works on the Link Road between the main gyrotory and the A27 (A2030) over two weekends in September. These works will necessitate a full road closure of the Link Rd from 22:00 on a Friday through to 06:00 the following Monday. The two weekends programmed for these works are Friday 9th September and Friday 16th September. I enclose a plan showing the diversion routes that will be operating during these closures.

I also attach a schedule of road closures, which provides details of our road and lane closure programme for the rest of August and through September. Fully signed diversion routes will be in place for the road closures. The works are dependant on multiple variables including weather and traffic flows, so it is possible that the dates will alter slightly as the works progress to deal with these issues.

We would like to stress that these works are being undertaken in such a way to minimise any disruption to the road user.

Certain operations will require the use of heavy breaking equipment and other noisy machinery. Where possible, we will endeavour to undertake these works at the beginning of a night shift to minimise disruption to local residents and businesses. However a certain amount of noise will be unavoidable, due to the nature of the works.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused by the scheme and appreciate your on-going co-operation. We will endeavour to complete the works as quickly as possible and with minimal disruption.

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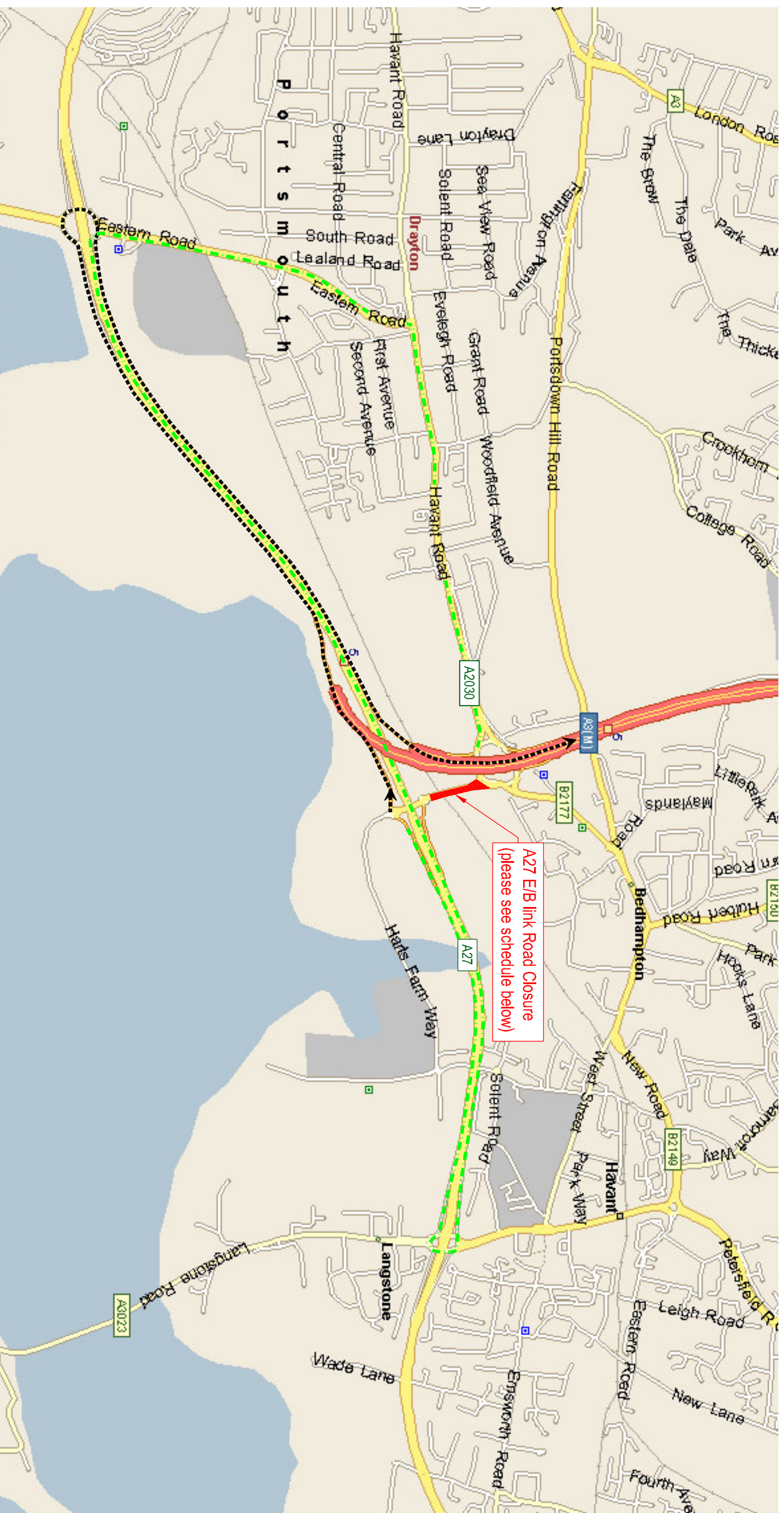
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A27 Eastbound (E/B) Link Road Closures and Diversion Routes
