Methods of working are developed which, where practicable, protect the environment and make efficient use of natural resources from renewable sources. The company endeavours to minimise the use of non-renewable resources and to use energy efficient, recycled and non-toxic products.

Dyer & Butler are committed to the reduction of office and construction waste. In doing so Dyer & Butler will:

-  Use energy efficient solutions wherever possible
-  Use recycled products
-  Recycle & reuse waste products where possible
-  Implement SWMPs on all projects
-  Reduce waste to landfill by 10% each year to achieve an overall 50% reduction by 2014

New contracts are reviewed to consider the significant environmental aspects and the associated impacts, and appropriate controls are put in place. All staff are encouraged to be aware of environmental issues and to manage carefully those that affect others, including waste, pollution control and noise.

The Integrated Management System is used to control the company's activities. All company personnel are required to comply with this Policy and work in accordance with the documented procedures. The company's objectives and targets, including environmental ones, are set, implemented, monitored, reviewed and procedures amended to ensure continual improvement. This Policy and the associated procedures are reviewed at least annually to ensure that company performance is continually improving and that we are keeping abreast of developments in environmental management.
